

## **MINUTES OF KINGSEAT COMMUNITY COUNCIL HELD ON MONDAY 17<sup>TH</sup> OCTOBER 2022**

### **PARK/MAIN STREET DRAINAGE**

Cllr Pryde gave an update he had received from Dr Hayes. The clearance work at the culvert has shown that further work is required. Screens will be recommended and while these are currently being put out to tender, Kingseat will be put on the list of areas needing work therefore it will be some time before the work can be completed. There was a request that FC endeavour to find out if the increased pipework had in fact been carried out by Taylor Wimpey and Cllr Pryde will make enquiries.

### **COMMUNITY COUNCIL UPGRADE**

Cllr Barrera suggested, following discussion with someone in the Council, that we put in a business plan. This is not deemed appropriate for the Community Council and we will contact Cllr Barrera to arrange a meeting with her contact in Fife Council so that we can discuss this with them.

### **GRIT BINS KEIRSBEATH RISE/LOCHWOOD PARK SIGN**

Cllr Ellis is dealing with these matters.

### **CHURCH STREET PARKING**

Cllrs Pryde and Ellis held an on-site meeting with FC and a plan is to be drawn up to provide additional spaces.

### **PLANNING GAIN FUNDS**

It was confirmed that the £45,000 has to be spent on the park area. Cllr Pryde will take this forward to see if there is any way we can get matched funding which might allow us the opportunity to put in a 'mini' MUGA. Cllr Pryde will contact Karen Hunter as the CC has discussed this matter with her previously.

### **LOCAL PLACE PLANS**

Forbes has responded to the communication and will also see if Norman would like to be involved with the Bellyeoman CC proposal for an informal link up.

### **RESUSCITATION CLASSES**

Forbes has contacted St John's and awaiting a response.

### **NATIONAL PRIDE**

Norman has contacted the new person involved with the scheme but has so far not received a response. Once Norman us back from holiday we will try and have another meeting with the company.

### **GRASS VERGE AT TAYLOR WIMPEY HOUSES**

Cllr Pryde advised that Steven Duffy held the view that this was the responsibility of Taylor Wimpey but he will raise it again with him.

## **AOCB**

- Les asked about arrangements for the Christmas tree, particularly the supply of a tabernacle to house the tree, Cllr Pryde will raise with Steven Duffy. Les also said help would be required to put the lights up. It is hoped to have the tree installed the last week in November with a community get together for the lights switch on. Cllr Pryde said he would be happy to come and lend a hand with the lights.
- Concerns have been expressed that bins are being wheeled around to the front street at the HHH development, when the arrangement had been the bin lorry should collect from the back. Cllr Pryde advised that there is not enough space around the back for the bin lorry but he will seek to clarify this.
